Re: Retroactive Engine Test Registration of the DD13 Scuffing Test

The American Chemistry Council (ACC) Product Approval Protocol Task Group (PAPTG) reached consensus to initiate retroactive registration of the DD13 Scuffing Test. The current test registration fee of \$100 per registered test will apply. This engine test should be appropriately displayed in all data summaries; including documents such as Candidate Data Packages (CDPs).

According to correspondence with the ASTM DD13 Surveillance Panel Chair, DD13 Scuffing Test stands were calibrated on March 1, 2016. Therefore, PAPTG reached consensus to retroactive registration for the DD13 Scuffing Test through the ACC Monitoring Agency (ACC MA). Retroactive registrations will be accepted through the ACC Monitoring Agency according to the conditions below.

DD13 Scuffing Test Retroactive Registration Conditions:

- Test sponsors may only request retroactive DD13 Scuffing Test registration with the ACC Monitoring Agency (ACC MA) from July 11, 2024 through October 11, 2024.
- Test sponsors are permitted to request retroactive registration for operationally valid DD13 Scuffing Test that started in calibrated stands on or after March 1, 2016, but before August 11, 2024.
- Normal registration, as per the ACC Code of Practice, will be permitted for all DD13 Scuffing Test starting on or after August 11, 2024.
