As Vice President of the American Chemistry Council's (ACC) Regulatory and Scientific Affairs Division, Kimberly oversees the development of ACC's policy positions in response to regulatory and legislative proposals. Most recently, she served as Senior Director for ACC's Chemical Products and Technology Division. She also represented industry in chemical policy discussions with various audiences, including testimony to U.S. House of Representatives and U.S. Senate Committees.

Previously, she served as a Scientific Advisor for the oil and natural gas industry where she was responsible for regulatory efforts and research programs focused on environmental, health, and safety.
